Meet the Goodenows

An orientation to the three brothers and one sister who, in 1638, left their homes in England, sailed to the Massachusetts Bay Colony, and helped to settle Sudbury, the 19th permanent town established in the Colony. The Immigrants were John Goodenow, his wife Jane, and daughters Lydia/Lidea and Jane; Thomas Goodenow, his wife Jane, and their children, Elizabeth and Thomas; Edmund Goodenow, his wife Ann, and their sons John and Thomas; and Ursula Goodenow, who never married.

Goodenow Family Tree Treasure Trove, by Bill Groenier, Information Manager (Ret'd)

A Newsworthy Birth on the Petersons' Farm.

GFA Life members Donna and Chuck Peterson have farmed and raised cattle for nearly 50 years in Illinois. In April 2020, as Americans were being urged to wear masks to reduce the transmission of Covid-19, one of the Petersons' cows gave birth to a black calf with a distinctive and unusual marking – a white band across its nose, resembling a mask. Though they toyed with the idea of naming the calf "Corona", they settled on "Mask" instead. This event was covered in the publication *Farm Week*.

Answers to Two Past Queries

A query that was published in the November 2019 issue of *Goodenows' Ghosts* sought information about the burial site of Lois R. Goodnow (1895-1963), as a means of

identifying the burial site of her husband, John Van Antwerp MacMurray, a U.S. diplomat. GFA Life member Christine Banvard-Fox reported that she uncovered the exact information that had been sought – the couple is buried in Center Cemetery, Norfolk, Litchfield County, CT.

A second query, from GFA member Robert Goodnow, had been printed in the August 2020 issue of *Goodenows' Ghosts*, seeking lineage information about a former neighbor, Ruth Mirick, who, unknown to Robert, was a Goodenow descendant. Christine Banvard-Fox, GFA Life member, found relevant information on a subscription genealogy website, which revealed that Ruth Lois Goodnow Mirick was descended from the Immigrant Thomas Goodenow.
